Adv. Deep Madnani submits that last date of hearing was intimated to Non-applicant in writing by letter dated 8th June, 2023. However inadvertently affidavit of service was not filed by Applicants. Today the Applicants have filed affidavit of service.

- 2] A perusal of affidavit of service would show that by letter dated 8th June, 2023 (page no. 77), the Applicants had given intimation of date 5th July, 2023 to other side in writing.
