2] By these Misc. Applications, Applicants are seeking to amend the captioned two appeals (i.e., Appeal Nos. AT00600000053439 and AT00600000053441) to substitute the names of Appellants against the names of original Appellants and also for all consequential amendments in both appeals by which, the name of the original Appellants i.e, Mr. Dhiren M. Shah and Champaben H. Galaiya are being replaced by the new Appellants i.e, Radhesh Welling and Hoshi A. Karanjia in the array of Appellants after the proposed amendments.

3] Learned counsel for Appellants/ Applicants further submit that these amendments are absolutely essential in the light of registered agreements for sale dated 13.02.2023 and 29.11.2022.

4] Learned counsel for Non-applicant vehemently opposed by submitting that these re-sale agreements have taken place by Applicants without N.O.C nor with the consent of Respondent/Non-applicant and the

re-sale agreements have not been signed by Respondent/ Non-applicant. Thereby, Applicants have no locus to sue Respondent for the alleged breaches as contended in appeals.

Perusal of documents reveals that these agreements for sale 5] have taken place, and these are essential for effective adjudication the disputes involved in these appeals.

6] In view of above, both these two Misc. Applications are allowed without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties, by keeping these open to rebut the same on merits.

Applicants to carry-out proposed amendments of substitution 71 of these two Applicants within 10 days and file amended copies of the appeal and serve to other side.

81 Liberty to Non-applicant to file additional reply, if any within 10 days thereafter.

Misc. Application Nos.289/2023 and 272/2023 are disposed of 91 on above terms.
